# Victory

The work of transformation requires grace-driven effort. This is us participating, giving in, cooperating with the Spirit that is at work in us.

## Philippians 2:12-13

...work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, <sup>13</sup> for it God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure.

## Romans 8:9-17

You, however, are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him. <sup>10</sup> But if Christ is in you, although the body is dead because of sin,
