¹⁶ All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, ¹⁷ that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.



Word-Saturated

“breathed out by God” refers to God’s initiative and influence as the source of Scripture.

2 Peter 1:20-21

knowing this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture comes from someone's own interpretation. ²¹ For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.

Word-Saturated

Four Ways the Word is Profitable:

1. For teaching
2. For reproof
3. For correction
4. For training in righteousness
