## John 12:27–36



# Lifted Up Was He to Die


1. God glorifies Himself by judging the world.

In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.




## John 12:27b-28


# Lifted Up Was He to Die

God glorifies Himself by judging this world.




# John 12:31

God glorifies Himself by casting out the ruler of this world, Satan.




# Lifted Up Was He to Die

<sup>32</sup> And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself.”


<sup>33</sup> He said this to show by what kind of death he was going to die.
