# EXODUS

THE GOD WHO REDEEMS



## Exodus 17:1-7 (ESV)

All the congregation of the people of Israel moved on from the wilderness of Sin by stages, according to the commandment of the Lord, and camped at Rephidim, but there was no water for the people to drink.

<sup>4</sup> So Moses cried to the Lord, “What shall I do with this people? They are almost ready to stone me.” <sup>5</sup> And the Lord said to Moses, “Pass on before the people, taking with you some of the elders of Israel,

and take in your hand the staff with which you struck the Nile, and go.

## Exodus 17:1-7 (ESV)

And Moses did so, in the sight of the elders of Israel. <sup>7</sup> And he called the name of the place Massah and Meribah, because of the quarreling of the people of Israel, and because they tested the Lord by saying, “Is the Lord among us or not?”

## Exodus 17:5-6(ESV)

<sup>5</sup> And the Lord said to Moses, “Pass on before the people, taking with you some of the elders of Israel, and take in your hand the staff with which you struck the Nile, and go. <sup>6</sup> Behold, I will stand before you there on the rock at Horeb, and you shall strike the rock, and water shall come out of it, and the people will drink.”



## Deuteronomy 1:30 (ESV)

**30 The LORD your God who goes before you will himself fight for you, just as he did for you in Egypt before your eyes,**

## Deuteronomy 9:3 (ESV)

<sup>3</sup> Know therefore today that he who goes over before you as a consuming fire is the LORD your God. He will destroy them and subdue them before you. So you shall drive them out and make them perish quickly, as the LORD has promised you.

## Deuteronomy 31:8 (ESV)

**8 It is the LORD who goes before you. He will be with you; he will not leave you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed.”**

## **Micah 2:13(ESV)**

**<sup>13</sup> He who opens the breach goes up  
before them;**

**They break through and pass the gate,  
going out by it.**

**Their king passes on before them,  
the LORD at their head.**

## John 10:4 (ESV)

**4 When he has brought out all his own, he goes before them, and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice.**



# 1 Corinthians 10:1 (ESV)

For I do not want you to be unaware, brothers, that our fathers were all under the cloud, and all passed through the sea, <sup>2</sup> and all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea, <sup>3</sup> and all ate the same spiritual food,

# 1 Corinthians 10:1 (ESV)

<sup>4</sup> and all drank the same spiritual drink. For they drank from the spiritual Rock that followed them, and the Rock was Christ. <sup>5</sup> Nevertheless, with most of them God was not pleased, for they were overthrown in the wilderness.
