# Exodus 20:1-14

And God spoke all these words, saying,  
2 "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery. 3 "You shall have no other gods before me. 4 "You shall not make for yourself a carved

image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth. <sup>5</sup> You shall not bow down to them or serve them, for I the LORD your God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of

the fathers on the children to the third and the fourth generation of those who hate me, <sup>6</sup> but showing steadfast love to thousands of those who love me and keep my commandments.

# Exodus 20:1-14

<sup>7</sup> You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain, for the Lord will not hold him guiltless who takes his name in vain. <sup>8</sup> “Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. <sup>9</sup> Six days you shall labor, and do all your work, <sup>10</sup> but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the Lord your God.

# Exodus 20:1-14

On it you shall not do any work, you, or your son, or your daughter, your male servant, or your female servant, or your livestock, or the sojourner who is within your gates. <sup>11</sup> For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea,



<sup>13</sup> “You shall not murder. <sup>14</sup> “You shall not commit adultery.





# Mark 7:20-23

Jesus said, "What comes out of a person is what defiles him. <sup>21</sup> **For from within**, out of the heart of man, come evil thoughts, **sexual immorality**, theft, murder, **adultery**, <sup>22</sup> coveting, wickedness, deceit, sensuality, envy, slander, pride, foolishness.

# Mark 7:20-23

<sup>23</sup> All these evil things come from within,  
and they defile a person."



## Mark 5:20, 27-32

For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. . . . You have heard that it was said, 'You shall not commit adultery.'<sup>28</sup> But I say to you that

everyone who looks at a woman with lustful intent has already committed adultery with her in his heart. <sup>29</sup> If your right eye causes you to sin, tear it out and throw it away. For it is better that you lose one of your members than that your whole body be thrown into hell.

<sup>30</sup> And if your right hand causes you to sin, cut it off and throw it away. For it is better that you lose one of your members than that your whole body go into hell.

# Mark 5:20, 27-32

<sup>31</sup> "It was also said, 'Whoever divorces his wife, let him give her a certificate of divorce.'  
<sup>32</sup> But I say to you that everyone who divorces his wife, except on the ground of sexual immorality, makes her commit adultery, and

whoever marries a divorced woman  
commits adultery.
