## Deuteronomy 18:15-18

“The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your brothers—it is to him you shall listen—<sup>16</sup> just as you desired of the Lord your God at Horeb on the day of the assembly, when you said,



# Deuteronomy 18:15-18

‘Let me not hear again the voice of the Lord my God or see this great fire any more, lest I die.’<sup>17</sup> And the Lord said to me, ‘They are right in what they have spoken.’<sup>18</sup> I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their brothers.



# Deuteronomy 18:15-18

And I will put my words in his mouth,

## John 6:13-14

So they gathered them up and filled twelve baskets with fragments from the five barley loaves left by those who had eaten. <sup>14</sup> When the people saw the sign that he had done, they said, "This is indeed the Prophet who is to come into the world!"



## Acts 3:22-24

Moses said, “The Lord God will raise up for you a prophet like me from your brothers. You shall listen to him in whatever he tells you. <sup>23</sup> And it shall be that every soul who does not listen to that prophet shall be destroyed from the people.”

# Acts 3:22-24

<sup>24</sup> And all the prophets who have spoken, from Samuel and those who came after him, also proclaimed these days.





# Hebrews 1:1-3

Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, <sup>2</sup> but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world.



# Hebrews 1:1-3

<sup>3</sup> He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power.





## 2 Corinthians 4:4-6

In their case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, to keep them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God. <sup>5</sup> For what we proclaim is not ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord,

with ourselves as your servants for Jesus' sake. <sup>6</sup> For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.
