He IS | Incomprehensible

God cannot be fully comprehended or understood.

We may know God truly, for he has revealed himself to us, but being finite creatures we can never know him fully.

God is INCOMPREHENSIBLE and yet He is KNOWABLE.

Why is God Incomprehensible?

1. God is infinite and we are finite.
2. The effects of sin on the human mind also greatly inhibit the ability to know God.
3. In His sovereign wisdom, God has chosen not to reveal some things to us.
