



## Jesus and His Superior Covenant 2 Tabernacle:

# God lives among sinners and sinners can't come near.

Lampstand:

Sinners are in darkness, but God will give light to us.

## **Jesus and His Superior Covenant 2** Table + The Bread of Presence: We are out of fellowship with God, but God will make a way to fellowship with US.

**Jesus and His Superior Covenant 2** Holy Place + Most Holy Place: God is separate from sinners, but someday sinners will be united with Him.

## Jesus and His Superior Covenant 2 Golden Altar of Incense:

God will hear the prayers and the cries of sinners and He will answer them.

**Jesus and His Superior Covenant 2** Ark of the Covenant: God reigns over His people in glory and power. Golden Urn holding manna: God provides for His people.

**Jesus and His Superior Covenant 2** Aaron's staff that budded: God brings miraculous new life to His people. Tablets of the Covenant: God instructs His people in His ways.

Jesus and His Superior Covenant 2 Cherubim of glory overshadowing the mercy seat:

God, while remaining gloriously holy, He will save, cleanse, purify sinners.



**Jesus and His Superior Covenant 2** The message of the Tabernacle was the necessity of the New Covenant. All people who come under the New Covenant will be the temple of the Holy Spirit; therefore you must be born-again [converted, cleansed, prepared, set in order and filled] so that you may truly WORSHIP Him.

Jesus and His Superior Covenant 2 We don't have holy places, but holy people. Jesus and His Superior Covenant 2 The New Testament knows no salvation that doesn't include sanctification. Jesus and His Superior Covenant 2 1. Justification is outside-in, and we lose it if we make it inside-out. 2. Sanctification is inside-out, and we lose it if we make it outside-in. 3. And this inside-out sanctification is largely fed by daily appropriation of this outside-in justification.
