# The Seated Son

## Sufficiency of the New Covenant:

1. It makes those who draw near to Jesus holy through His perfect obedience.
2. It provides forgiveness of sins AND new hearts.

The cross is not just the means by which we receive forgiveness for our sins, but also the means by which our whole lives and worlds are **CHANGED**.
