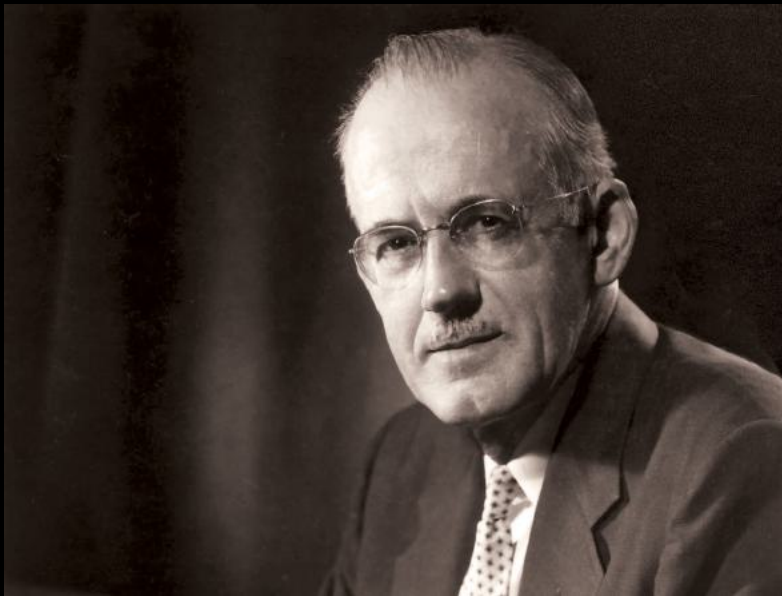

God Most Holy

Holiness can be defined as the sum of all moral excellency.

The antitheses of all moral blemish or defilement.

It carries the idea of being set apart, sacred, separate, of possessing utter purity of character.

God possess a holiness that is so blinding that no one can look on him and live, a moral purity so devastating that not even the sinless angelic beings who inhabit his immediate presence can bear to look upon him, instead shielding their gaze with wings and day and night they never cease to say: holy, holy, holy...



God Most Holy

God's holiness sets him apart. He is separated from sin and devoted to seeking His own honor.

We are set apart from Him BY sin and are devoted to seeking our own honor.

God Most Holy

Christ has come in perfect holiness to create a truly holy people.
