

Sacrifices That Are Pleasing to God Experience sustaining grace as you remember and imitate the example of past faithful leaders.

Hebrews 13:7

Hebrews 13:8 ⁸ Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.

Sacrifices That Are Pleasing to God The same Jesus that saved, fed, sustained and changed past faithful leaders is the same Jesus that is available to you.

Sacrifices That Are Pleasing to God Experience sustaining grace as you feast on the gospel of Christ. Hebrews 13:9 ⁹ Do not be led away by diverse and strange teachings, for it is good for the heart to be strengthened by grace, not by foods, which have not benefited those devoted to them.

Hebrews 13:10 ¹⁰ We have an altar from which those who serve the tent have no right to eat.
